

Is Your Love Life In Jeopardy?



This workshop is for self-advocates to answer the questions but family members and agency staff can also attend.



Come to this exciting workshop to learn more about relationships in a fun and carefree way by playing the game JEOPARDY. This is not played exactly like the real Jeopardy Game instead we just ask 'multiple choice' or 'true or false' questions and ask the audience for the answers. We made a board from a cardboard tri-fold. We have 5 categories of questions to choose from: MARRY, DATE OR DUMP; TO KISS OR NOT TO KISS; MEET THE PARENTS; MEN ARE FROM MARS, WOMEN ARE FROM VENUS and THAT SOMEONE SPECIAL. We use a different color for each category. We have a \$10, \$20, \$30, \$40 and \$50 question for each category. Below are the questions we used but we can create more questions if needed. **The conference committee should feel free to suggest additional questions.**

MARRY, DATE OR DUMP

\$10 BLUE Question: You met someone at the National Self-Advocacy Dance and you danced together for 3 dances. You are not sure if you are attracted to this person but you had a nice time dancing with them. Do you?

- A. Marry
- B. Date
- C. Dump

\$20 BLUE Question: You talk to your sweetie on the phone almost daily. You have asked them several times to go out to the movies or to dinner. Your sweetie always says they are too busy. Do you?

- A. Marry
- B. Date
- C. Dump

\$30 BLUE Question: You meet someone at a self-advocacy club meeting and take time to talk to them afterwards. You find you have similar interests. This person calls you and asked you to go to lunch. Do you?

- A. Marry
- B. Date
- C. Dump

\$40 BLUE Question: You have shared personal information with your honey and your honey has shared that information with others, on several occasions. Should you?

- A. Marry
- B. Date
- C. Dump

\$50 BLUE Question: You have been on 2 dates with a person. Your body/mind tells you not to go on the 3rd date, since you have felt uncomfortable, even though you can not put your finger on it. Do you?

- A. Marry
- B. Date
- C. Dump

TO KISS OR NOT TO KISS

\$10 RED Question: You **do not** owe your date a kiss even when your date has paid for dinner.

True or False

\$20 RED Question: Taking the Birth Control Pill **does not** keep you and your partner safe from Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STDs).

True or False

\$30 RED Question: You really want to kiss your sweetie but you have not kissed them before. What do you do?

- A. Explain to you sweetie that you would really like to give them a kiss and ask them if it is ok.
- B. Just kiss your sweetie.
- C. Don't kiss your sweetie and go away disappointed.

\$40 RED Question: It is ok to tell your sweetie when something doesn't feel good during sex.

True or False

\$50 RED Question: Your honey wants to have sex but you are not ready. You are afraid you may lose your honey if you do not have sex. What do you do?

- A. You tell your honey that you are not ready and that they need to respect that you are not ready.
- B. Try not to be alone with your honey so you won't feel pressured.
- C. You have sex with your honey because you don't want your honey to leave you.

THAT SOMEONE SPECIAL

\$10 PURPLE Question: If you see someone at the dance this weekend that you are attracted to—what could you do?

- A. Talk to your friend about how cool that person looks.
- B. Go over and introduce yourself.
- C. Be loud and hope the person notices you.

\$20 PURPLE Question: If you have sexual feelings for someone of the same sex and have questions about those feelings, who could you contact?

- A. Therapist or Counselor
- B. Internet to find local group for example, Atlanta Pride, Outright Vermont, Equality California
- C. Someone you trust and believes in you.
- D. All of the above.

\$30 PURPLE Question: Which of the following is not a safe form of birth control?

- A. Condoms
- B. Diaphragm
- C. Withdrawal/ Pulling Out
- D. Birth Control Pills

\$40 PURPLE Question: Where can you go to meet other single people?

- A. Local self-advocacy group.

- B. Church, Synagogue or Mosque.
- C. Doing your hobbies.
- D. All of the Above.

\$50 PURPLE Question: How do you tell your honey they have bad body odor?

- A. Tell them "You Stink"
- B. Buy different types of deodorant and soaps and leave them in their bedroom.
- C. Privately tell them that you have noticed an unpleasant body odor.

MEET THE PARENTS

\$10 GREEN Question: What do you do if your parents tell you they do not want you to date because it is too much responsibility?

\$20 GREEN Question: What do you do if one of your family member's tells you they do not like your honey?

\$30 GREEN Question: What do you do if your honey will not spend time with your parents because they say they do not like them?

- C. Ask your honey what they do not like about your parents.

\$40 GREEN Question: When having dinner with your sweetie's parents for the first time - it is important to...?

- C. That you burp loudly.
- D. Track mud into the living room.

\$50 GREEN Question: You have been dating your sweetie for several months and would

like to meet their parents. You have told your sweetie several times that you would like to meet their parents. What should you do?

- A. Break up with your sweetie and tell them you never want to see them again.
- B. Talk to your sweetie and asked them why they do not want you to meet their parents.
- C. Call the parents and tell them you want to meet them.

MEN ARE FROM MARS, WOMEN ARE FROM VENUS

\$10 ORANGE Question: Your sweetie always wants to hang out with their friends. You like to have some time with just your sweetie - alone. What do you do?

\$20 ORANGE Question: The best way to ask a person out on a date is to say.....?

- B. Hey you and me we are going out this Friday. I will meet you at 6:00 pm.
- C. I enjoy talking to you and I would like to go out to lunch with you. Would you be interested in going on a date with me?

\$40 ORANGE Question: What is Dutch Treat?
